-Mission area schools and the West Kelowna schools catchment reviews are underway. Survey #1 closed Sept 30. Survey #2 will run Nov 3-24. Staff will then come forward with recommendations. Last survey on recommendations will run Dec 1-15. Decisions to be made by Trustees end of January 2022. Parent participation is strongly encouraged. Stakeholders requested that families with children outside these catchments be included in the consultation process.
